

How to find and export student test score data

1. Click the SYSTEM link under setup and go to Direct Database Export (DDE). Search the “Test” table (choose from drop down) for the test that you want to find; for example, if you are searching for GQE test results, search the Test Table for records where the Name Value (chosen from the drop down) contains GQE. Example: **Name=GQE**
2. PowerSchool should return one record. Click List View to view the contents of that record.
3. Note the value of the ID field in the Test Record. For this example, the ID value of GQE is 11. Follow the breadcrumbs back to DDE.
4. Search the TestScore table (from dropdown) for records where the TestID field value equals 11. (The ID noted in the previous step.) Use the list view link and you will see 2 types of test score, English and Math.
5. The TestScore table also has an ID Field. For this example, the TestScore record for English name has an ID value of 18 and Math is 19. Use breadcrumbs back to DDE.
6. Search the StudentTestScore table for records where the TestScoreID value equals 18.
7. Search the StudentTestScore Table for records where AlphaScore=F to get a list of F’s. (Use the search bar to search within current records)
8. Click the Export Records link and use a selection of the following fields to get the information you require.
